An online meeting of the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) of the Department of Sociology was held on 06/10/2020 at 3:30 PM to discuss the set agenda and to take decisions on the same. Prof. P. H. Mohammad, Head, Department of Sociology & Ex-officio Chairperson of the DRC, has chaired the meeting and Dr. Saheed Meo and Dr. K. M. Ziyauddin, both Assistant Professors, Department of Sociology, MANUU, have participated the meeting as a member and special invitee, respectively. While the third/external member nominated on DRC has resigned from the same and there has been delay in nominating the external member in his place and hence only the above members attended the meeting forming the quorum. The Chairman informed that the DRC is to be held once in every six months. However due to Covid – 19 problem and the lockdown of the country/university, the last meeting that was due to be held was not conducted. In this regard the following resolutions are passed;

1. Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting held on 21/08/2020:

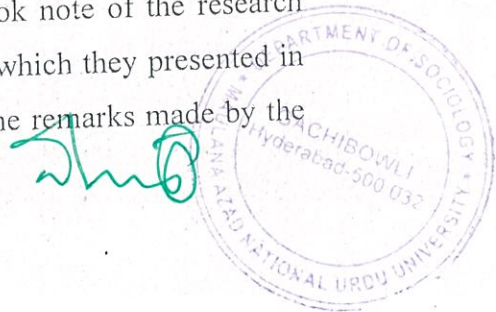
The minutes of the previous DRC meeting held on 21/08/2020 have been confirmed.

Ziyauddin, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, as the research supervisor of Ph. D scholars of the department subject other terms and conditions prescribed by the university and other academic regulations. Further, following the approval of the item no. 36.4.03 (MANUU/ACAD/ F. 67/2019-20/274), in the 36th meeting of the Academic Council, MANUU, held on 3rd October 2019, resolving to extend the research supervision, of Ph. D scholars, to all the members of faculty (with concerned subject) of the Directorate of Distance Education (DDE), MANUU, subject

to minimum conditions prescribed in the Ph. D regulations, the matter was deliberated in the DRC and Dr. Malik Rayhan Ahmad, Assistant Professor (Sociology), Directorate of Distance Education (DDE), MANUU, is inducted to supervise the Ph. D scholars in the department of Sociology, subject to other such terms and conditions prescribed by the university and other regulations.

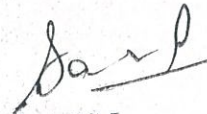

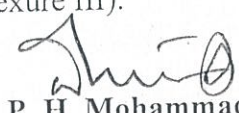

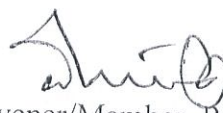
